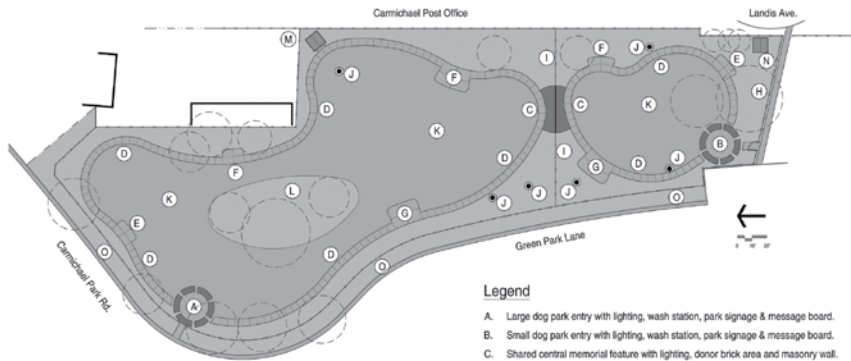




The Canine Corral Needs Your Help....



Carmichael Park Dog Park Master Plan

Legend

- A. Large dog park entry with lighting, wash station, park signage & message board.
- B. Small dog park entry with lighting, wash station, park signage & message board.
- C. Shared central memorial feature with lighting, donor brick area and masonry wall.
- D. 5' wide paved walkway, typ.
- E. Paved area with permanent seating.
- F. Paved area with permanent seating, shade structure and drinking fountain.
- G. Paved group social area with permanent seating, shade structure, drinking fountain and dog water feature.
- H. Existing fence at Landis Ave. entry to be relocated closer to entry walkway.
- I. New 6' high chain link fence with privacy slats separating large and small dog areas.
- J. Existing tree to be removed, typ.
- K. Open turf area, typ.
- L. Engineered wood fiber area, typ.
- M. Relocated storage shed.
- N. New small dog park storage shed.
- O. New 6' high chain link perimeter fence along Carmichael Park Rd. and Green Park Ln.

The Canine Corral has been in operation for approximately ten years and is in desperate need of renovation. It currently lacks a proper infrastructure, and poor drainage has caused standing pools of water resulting in illnesses to both pets and owners. It offers minimal shade, walkways and permanent seating. Throughout the winter, the Dog Park floods and is unusable. A Master Plan to renovate the Dog Park was approved by the Carmichael Park and Recreation District but now funds must be raised to make this project a reality.

Does your dog need discipline? Help your pet better understand what you want by learning basic commands such as heel, sit, come, down, stay and many more. Dogs or puppies must be four months old and have all their DHLPP and Rabies shots. Proof of vaccinations MUST be presented on the first day of class. Please bring a 4 or 6 foot nylon or leather leash and a regular collar.
