## Trees

Tree species options have been approved by Sacramento Tree Foundation for site placement which allows the tree to thrive in its environment given the proper soil and climate. You may choose from four species of tree: Zelkova (15 inch box), Willow Oak (15 inch box), Tupelo (24 inch box), or Trident Maple (24 inch box). Your contribution will allow your commemorative tree to be planted at the site best suited for its success, determined in advance by both CRPD Parks Services staff and the donor.

## Benches

Material options for a bench donation include plastic, metal with vinyl coating, or concrete (see images below). The plaque allows for 3 lines and number of characters will be determined by bench selected and is included in your contribution. It takes approximately 8 weeks for the bench to be fabricated. It takes approximately 8 weeks for installation. The bench and plaque pricing are subject to change according to manufacturer's pricing. The exact park site and location will be discussed with the donor by the CRPD Parks Services staff who will coordinate and install the bench(es) as time allows.

## Bricks

Memorial bricks are standard in size and will be placed with other bricks as space allows. The donor's brick can contain up to three (3) lines of 15 characters each, ALL CAPS, including spaces. The exact park site and location will be discussed with the donor by the CRPD Parks Services staff who will coordinate and install the brick(s) as time allows.
