Subject: 2021 California Clean Air Day Event

Information:

The California Clean Air Day is Wednesday, October 6, 2021! One of our FY 2021-22 Work Plan key initiatives is working as a District to be more sustainable. We feel that planting more trees in in our parks/facilities is one step in that process. So, Carmichael Recreation and Park District is partnering with the Kiwanis Club of Carmichael and the Sacramento Tree Foundation to plant 12 trees at La Sierra Community Center at 11:00 am, as part of a California Clean Air Day event.

The Kiwanis Club of Carmichael was awarded a \$1000 grant to help with costs associated with the event. All the organizations involved are asked to take the pledge to do our part in cleaning up the air quality here in the Sacramento area. Members of the three (3) organizations involved are also looking to have the media and elected/appointed officials attend the event.
