Subject:	Bond and Disclosure Counsel Services for Election 2022 for the potential issuance of General Obligation Bonds Agreement between Carmichael Recreation & Park District and Jones Hall

#### Background/Discussion:

Over the last 8 weeks several members of the Ad Hoc Committee have made presentation seeking feedback from our community stakeholders regarding CRPD's financial needs when it comes to deferred maintenance and improved amenities highlighted in the Master Plan update. Overall, we received positive feedback and it is leading the Ad Hoc Committee towards placing a bond measure on the November 2022 ballot. We will be coming to you at the June Advisory Board meeting for further discussion and recommendation on moving forward. As part of this on-going process, we have been advised to seek Bond and Disclosure Counsel Services at this time in preparation.

On May 6, 2022 CRPD performed outreach on a Request for Proposal (RFP), advertising through a list of Bond Counsel Services and the District Website. The RFP process was supported by CRPD's Financial Planning and Advisory Service consultant Jon Isom. The purpose of the RFP was to solicit responses from qualified firms to provide Bond and Disclosure Counsel Services for Election 2022 for the potential issuance of General Obligation Bonds.

The deadline to receive proposals was May 13, 2022. Three firms responded to the RFP, all of them were high tiered firms, qualified and experienced. District Staff and Mr. Isom reviewed and performed follow up on the proposal. We also consulted with County Staff and learned

that the County has worked with each of the three firms and recommends their services. Review criteria results:

- Proposal objectives were addressed. The respondent had an understanding of the work to be performed;
- The respondent has the qualifications, licensing, knowledge, background, and experience to perform the services;
- The firm's reputation, ethics and values aligned with no past or present legal proceedings or complaints filed against them.

## Here are the key categories of services and associated fees that were included in the Proposal (attached):

- Pre-election Services
- Bond Counsel Cost per Series
- Disclosure Counsel per Series
- Reimbursable expenses

Funding Sources for the various Services as determined by the CA Attorney General's Office:

- Bond Counsel and Disclosure Counsel Fees Fees would be paid from the bond funds contingent upon a successful election.
- Pre-election service fees to draft the resolution calling for the election would be paid from the District's Budget if the election is successful.

#### **Budget and Fiscal Impact**

There is no budget impact at this time. However, as stated, if the election is successful, CRPD will be responsible for the pre-election service fees of \$2,500 which will be paid from the funds allocated for the project. Over \$110k is available.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends that the Advisory Board award a contract to Jones Hall, a Professional Law Corporation. Not only did Jones Hall meet the RFP criteria but they have extensive related experience assisting recreation and park districts and school districts with bond issuance and disclosure services.

Because of an aggressive timeline to move forward on the Project, we are recommending that the Advisory Board authorize the District Administrator to negotiate and execute a contract with Jones Hall. Staff has drafted a contract which includes the terms and conditions from the RFP.

## ADDENDUM TO FEE PROPOSAL OF JONES HALL TO SERVE AS BOND AND DISCLOSURE COUNSEL TO THE CARMICHAEL RECREATION AND PARK DISTRICT

This addendum alters the Fee Proposal portion of our Proposal and Statement of Qualifications to serve as Bond and Disclosure Counsel to the Carmichael Recreation and Park District. In consideration of Jones Hall serving the combined roles of Bond Counsel and Disclosure Counsel our Fee Proposal is amended to be a flat combined fee of \$55,000 per series of bonds issued. Reimbursable expenses remain capped at a maximum of \$2,500 per series, and the one-time charge for pre-election services remains at \$2,500.

**E.** Additional Information. As bond counsel to the District, we would engage with the financing team to prepare for a November bond election. As a resolution calling an election, which includes all language to be included on the ballot, must be submitted to the County on August 10, we would immediately begin collaborating with respect to the legal requirements of calling an election and ballot language. Below is a brief summary of the services we provide as bond and disclosure counsel:

*Pre-Election Services.* As bond counsel to the District, we will provide the following pre-election legal services:

- 1. Preparation of a timetable setting forth the actions required to be undertaken to hold the election, and coordination with County election officials to ensure that the necessary legal requirements are satisfied.
- 2. Preparation of the resolution of the District's board required to call the election and to request consolidation with any other elections to be held on the same date.
- 3. Preparation of the resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County ordering consolidation of the election.
- 4. Assistance with the preparation of the tax rate statement and the County Counsel's independent analysis to be distributed to voters.
- 5. Review of the ballot arguments to be prepared by or on behalf of the District.
- 6. Consultation with the District and its staff, the County and its staff, and Isom Advisors, the District's financial advisor, concerning the election proceedings and campaign law requirements.
- 7. Review of information campaign activities and documents proposed for use by the District to ensure compliance with applicable law.
- 8. Preparation of the notices, affidavits and certificates required by law for the conducting of the election.

**Post-Election Services.** Following the District's successful bond election, we will provide the following services:

- 1. Consultation with the District and its staff, the County and Isom Advisors concerning the bonds and the timing, terms and structure of the offering thereof, including an examination of any alternative methods of issuance available to the District.
- 2. Preparation of the proceedings for the authorization and issuance of the bonds, including the resolution of the District's board setting forth the terms and conditions of the bonds and their form, date, denominations and maturity, and preparation of the proceedings for the sale of the bonds.
- 3. Preparation of the Preliminary and Final Official Statements.
- 4. Participation in preparation for, and attendance at, rating agency presentations.
- 5. Preparation of the bonds, and final closing papers, organization and conducting of the bond closing and the rendering of a final legal opinion at the time of delivery of and receipt for payment of the bonds.

#### LEGAL ISSUES

**No disputes.** Jones Hall has no pending legal actions, and has not been subject to any settlements or judgment in the last five years. In addition, all of our attorneys are in good standing with the California State Bar. There are no matters to disclose, civil or criminal and Jones Hall has not been subject to any of the claims listed in Request to Proposals in the last five years.

#### FEE PROPOSAL

**Bond Counsel and Disclosure Counsel Services.** We understand that the District is seeking proposals for legal work in connection with a proposed November 2022 bond election in the approximate amount of \$32 million. Services required include both bond counsel and disclosure counsel services.

We propose a flat fee of \$40,000 per series of bonds issued for bond counsel services, and \$25,000 per series of bonds issued for disclosure counsel services. In addition, reimbursable expenses relating to each proposed series of bonds will be capped at \$2,500 (not including legal publications if needed or orders from California Municipal Statistics if ordered on behalf of the District). Our fees do not increase, regardless of issues that may arise or the amount of time that may be spent working to ensure the success of the District's financing.

Please note that in addition to the foregoing, as compensation for legal services performed prior to the election date, we charge a one-time \$2,500 flat fee, payable from lawfully available funds of the District following the bond election.

**Contingent Fees Paid from Bond Proceeds**. Jones Hall is paid, from proceeds of the financing, only upon the successful sale and issuance of bonds. We do not bill hourly rates unless specifically requested to do so. Our contingent fees include all reasonable follow-up work done at the request of the District, so that our fees are paid only once, at the closing of the financing.

*Willingness to Negotiate Fees*. We very much welcome the opportunity to serve as bond and disclosure counsel to the District, and we are willing to negotiate our proposed fees.

#### **CLOSING STATEMENT SUPPORTING SELECTION OF JONES HALL AS BOND COUNSEL**
